

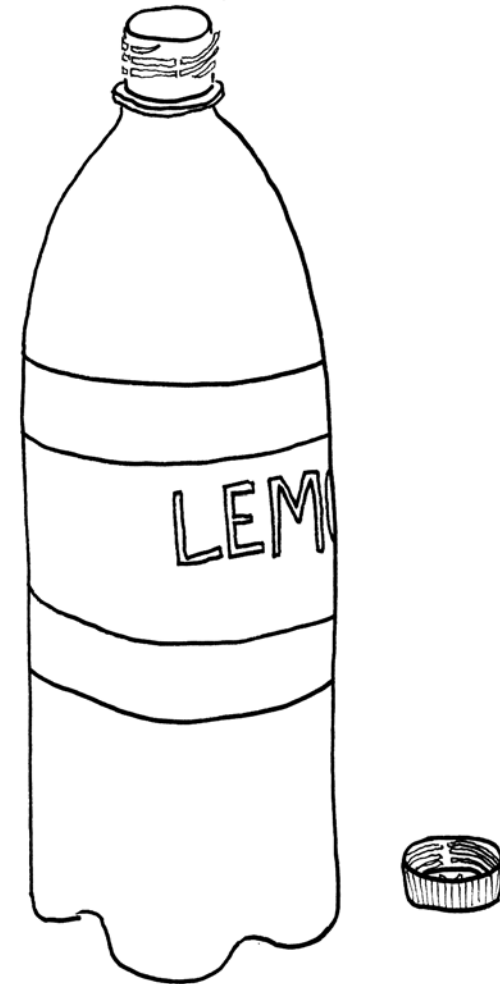

THE MASSIVE PICNIC BLANKET | HOW TO MAKE IT

You'll need the following:

- Picnic blankets (quantity depends on how big you want it)
- Needle and plenty of thread
- Adjustable straps

1. Firstly, sew two blankets together along the edges. Once these are joined, add more to all sides. Remember to keep track of which part of the blanket you're sewing, especially if you want it to be a square or rectangular shape. It may help to have a diagram at hand, and tick off the ones you've done.

2. Neatly fold up the finished blanket until it's compact, then position the adjustable straps around it. Adjust as required, so that it can be worn comfortably as a rucksack!
