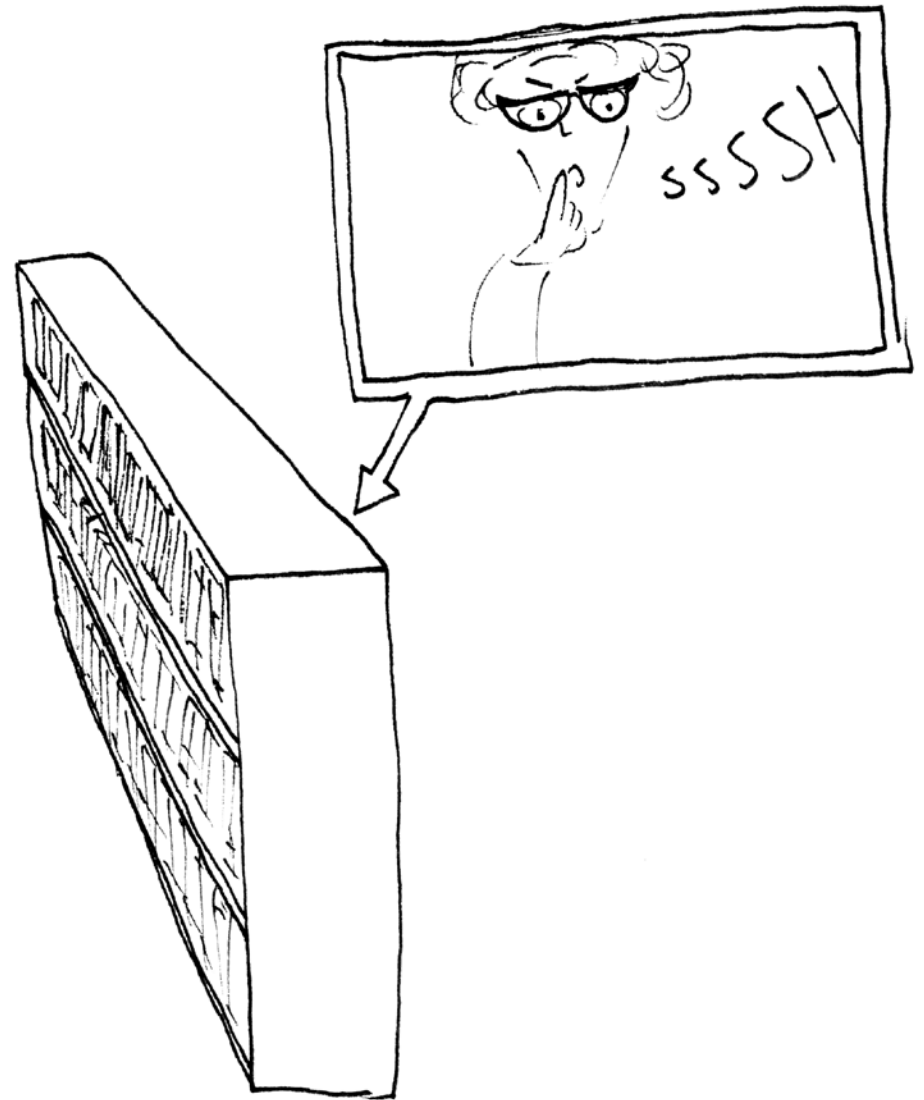


THE SINGING LIBRARY BOOK

THE SINGING LIBRARY BOOK | THE STORY

Here's an anonymous intervention for breaking that silence. The Make and Undo way is not to hurt anybody and not to break the law, but to find the line and quietly cross it.



THE SINGING LIBRARY BOOK | HOW TO MAKE IT

You'll need the following:

- Singing birthday cards
- Scissors or a scalpel
- Masking tape
- A library

1. Firstly, remove the circuitry from the birthday cards using a scalpel or pair of scissors. You'll notice how it operates, with a strip of card attached to the opposing page so when you open it, the music is triggered.

2. Armed with your circuits, and some pre-cut strips of masking tape, scour the library for your chosen targets. Remember to attach the strip of card to the inside cover of the book.

3. Putting the books carefully back in place, leave as subtly as you came.
